Tattoo Aftercare

STAGE ONE - DAYS 1-3

1.1

With Adhesive Barrier

Keep on for up to 3 days. On day 3, peel off the adhesive barrier. Upon removal, wash the tattooed area with lukewarm water & anti-bacterial soap.

1.2

Without Adhesive Barrier - Dry Healing

The adhesive barrier can be removed once you get home, if it was applied at the studio. Upon removal, wash the tattoo right away with lukewarm water and anti-bacterial soap. For the remaining days of Stage One, wash your tattoo 2-3 times a day.

STAGE TWO - DAYS 4-14

2.0

Scabbing & New Skin

During this period, you may apply the lotion to moisturize your tattoo when it is feeling tight or itchy from dryness. You should also wash your tattoo 2-3 times a day.

STAGE THREE - DAYS 14-30+

3.0

Healed (almost??)

At this point, the skin is almost completely renewed and looking like skin. Scabbing is no longer visible and it looks like normal skin again.

Lotion can be used to hydrate the skin. Use sunblock to protect the tattoo from extreme exposure to the sun.

Healing Tips For *Best Results!*



01

When washing or moisturizing...

...be sure to wash your hands first.

02

Wash your tattoo 2-3 times a day...

In the morning, at night, and anytime in between

03

When drying your tattoo...

Pat dry with single use paper towel.

04

When moisturizing with lotion/balm...

..use a pea sized amount for every 5x5".

05

Keep it out of the sun...

... to prevent fading or photo-reactive burning in tattooed area.

06

No baths or exposure to sitting water.....

...that will cause over hydration that prevents proper healing.

07

No picking, scratching, peeling..

... this can cause scarring and loss of ink in the skin.

08

No hot showers or temperatures.....

... heat irritation can lead to improper healing.

CUREL (*LOTION*)

Ingredients: Water, Glycerin, Petrolatum, Cetearyl Alcohol, Dimethicone, Behentrimonium Chloride, Isopropyl Palmitate, Cetyl-PG Hydroxyethyl Palmitamide, Isopropyl Alcohol, Butylene Glycol, Hydroxyactophenone, Benzalkonium Chloride, Citrus Aurantium Dulcis (Orange) Peel Oil, Avena Sativa (Oat) Meal Extract, Eucalyptus Globulus Leaf Extract, Sodium Lauroyl Lactylate, Ceramide NP, Ceramide AP, Phytosphingosine, Cholesterol, Xanthan Gum, Ethylhexylglycerin, Polyacrylic Acid, Ceramide EOP, Limonene.



DIAL (*SOAP*)

Ingredients: Triclosan 0.15%, Water, Sodium Laureth Sulfate, Cocamidopropyl Betaine, Sodium Chloride, Cocamidopropyl Hydroxysultaine, Glycerin, Fragrance, Polyquaternium-7, PEG-2 Hydroxyethyl Coco/Isostearamide, DMDM Hydantoin, Tetrasodium EDTA, Citric Acid, Yellow 5, Red 4.
